The **Cliffs of Moher** are one of Ireland's top visitor attractions. The Cliffs are 214m high at the highest point and range for 8 kilometres over the Atlantic Ocean on the western seaboard of County Clare. From the Cliffs one can see the Aran Islands, Galway Bay, as well as The Twelve Pins, the Maum Turk Mountains in Connemara and Loop Head to the South. The Cliffs of Moher are one of the major colonies of cliff nesting seabirds in Ireland with 20 species of nesting birds including 9 species of breeding seabirds and up to 30,000 breeding pairs.



ATLANTIC EDGE EXHIBITION

In the visitor centre is the ideal way to learn about the Cliffs. The "Ledge Theatre" gives a virtual reality birds eye view of Cliff edge life above and below sea level.

O'BRIEN'S TOWER

Built in 1835 and restored in 2008, O'Brien's Tower stands near the highest point of the Cliffs at 214m. The views from the top are spectacular, the tower is open daily for tours to the top.



CLIFFS OF MOHER VISITOR CENTRE

The eco-friendly visitor centre operates using environmental best practices focusing on good water and waste management, energy saving measures and environmental awareness. Opened in 2007, the centre uses geo-thermal heating, solar panel, waste water treatment and sensor lighting.
